


Solo Dancers

Hazel Jones R.I.P

The first time I recall meeting Hazel was in the kitchen of the Artarmon Public School hall on the first Friday night that I was asked to call for Greenwich Swingers Square Dance Club. Hazel seemed to be very quiet and unassuming, but I quickly realized that she was a well organized lady who attended to everything with great efficiency.

Hazel went on to tell me how she was involved with Overseas Humanitarian Aid. She told me she would arrange for superseded medical, office & building equipment to be collected, transferred to shipping containers and then delivered to the Philippines where

it was desperately needed.

Hazel was also the driving force behind organizing special "theme nights" for the Greenwich Swingers Square Dance Club, for which her husband (Glyn) was President. She had a knack of involving key club members who had special fields of expertise to help in various ways with unique stage decorations, novelty demonstrations and fancy dress parades during the evening.





In 2009 Hazel & Glyn arranged & led

a square dance tour to the Philippines, which was an extension of Hazel's on-going Humanitarian Aid. However, this time the aid was in the form of a cultural nature. Her intention was that during this two-week trip, the touring square dancers would teach square dancing to 2,000 university students of the Baguio University.

About eighteen dancers, representing three Australian States participated in this amazing square dance adventure. The group assembled at Sydney Airport, then flew from there to Manilla, where we stayed overnight. The following morning our group travelled by car & mini bus to Baguio, which is

considered to be the "Winter Capital" of the Philippines.

After settling into our accommodation, the group, led by Hazel & Glyn, visited the Baguio University, where we were officially welcomed by leading staff.

Each day Hazel & Glyn had arranged that we would teach square dancing to groups of students in the University Basket Ball stadium from 9:00am until 5:00pm. Each one-hour session would consist of 11 to 30 sets of students. They would dance the whole session – without breaks.

Hazel had also arranged for our group to visit, and teach square dancing at a local orphanage in Baguio. Before

Don't scuff your feet.

In different dances, we are asked to glide, brush, drag, pull, limp, scoot, and maybe to do a "floor" ronde, but we are not really supposed to scrape or shuffle our feet along the surface of the floor. If those in the seats can hear the "shoosh, shoosh" of our passing, especially if it goes so far as to interrupt their quiet conversation, then we need to pick up our feet. Am I so hard of hearing that I can't hear these scrapings? Am I weak or lazy and unable to pick them up? Probably I just can't think of too many different things at the same time. Skim just above the surface of the floor, but not on the floor.

Don't look at your partner.

It's ironic. Here, we have our partners in our arms, the music is sweet, the lights are low, the mood is romantic—and we can't gaze into their eyes. We really do need to keep our heads up and our eyes left, most of the time. It is a question of our individual balance and our counterbalance relative to our partner. If we look at our partner, whether it is adoringly or questioningly, we shift our own balance toward her. Both of our positions are disturbed. She will feel pushed. Our frame loosens, and she won't feel a clear lead or will feel the wrong lead. Men, you may worship your partner, but do it a bit from afar.

Don't grimace or scowl.

The casual view of dancing is one of lightness and joy. It is the carefree flitting of the butterfly among soft, meadow breezes. But we dancers have a more complete picture. Some of those routines are demonic, requiring hard work and concentration. So what do you do as you listen to the cues, furiously struggle to turn those sometimes meaningless words into coordinated action, think about what your partner is doing and what you might do to facilitate and mesh with all that, and maybe keep an eye on nearby dancers with a view to avoiding collisions? Do you frown? Squint with the effort and purse or twist your lips in concentration? Do you emit little grunts or squeals of pain and frustration? Well, don't do that. This is fun; it's your recreation—smile.

leaving Australia, Hazel, with the help of other ladies had made special square dance skirts which she gave to girls in the orphanage – the expression on these girls faces said-it-all.

After a long illness Hazel Jones died in 2019. She was an amazing, unassuming lady who not only had great empathy for humanity, but did a great deal more than most for those who were less fortunate.

EMERGENCY CALL FOR MEDICAL AID



- When a dancer goes down, a second dancer attends him/her.
- Remaining couples join hands and take a step backward. This will allow the injured person and attendant air and room.
- Raise joined hands as high as possible in the form of an arched circle.
- On seeing this signal, the caller or hall monitor will immediately place an Emergency Call for Medical Aid.
